

Class A Sewer Sludge

- Pathogens are reduced to levels similar to the native soil and environment
- Can be used on home lawns, gardens, parks, golf courses, and public places

Class B Sewer Sludge

- Designation for treated sewer sludge
- Allowed to have detectable pathogens
- Only allowed on lands with little public contact
- PFAS compounds present in all sewer sludge, no documentation by DEC to dispute that
